

**RESOLUTION NO. 1266-0323**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SHELTON, WASHINGTON DECLARING A CERTAIN CITY-OWNED EM&R VEHICLE SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING ITS SALE AS PROVIDED BY LAW AND CITY POLICY.**

**WHEREAS**, RCW 35A.11.010 and 35A.79.010 allow a municipal code city to dispose of property for the common benefit; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff have identified one vehicle that is no longer of use for City operations and the sale of this vehicle would be in the best interest of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, City Policy 300-20 directs the acting resolution to include the method of which an asset will be disposed, if not utilizing Washington State’s Department of Enterprise Services for sale of the asset, and

**WHEREAS**, Shelton Cemetery District has offered to purchase the vehicle for \$3,600, and

**WHEREAS**, City Staff has determined this to be a fair offer, as the Kelley Blue Book private party value estimate for the vehicle is in the range of \$3,027 and \$4,188; and

**WHEREAS**, the vehicle was originally purchased using the City’s Equipment, Maintenance & Rental fund; and

**WHEREAS**, a public hearing is not required for the surplus of this item, as it was not originally purchased for a public utility.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Shelton, Washington, as follows:

**Section 1. Declaration of Surplus Personal Property.** The following property of the City of Shelton EM&R Department is hereby declared surplus to the needs of the City of Shelton:

**Section 2. Authorization to Sell and Dispose of Surplus Personal Property.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to sell and dispose of the Surplus Personal Property identified in Section 1 by direct transaction to the Shelton Cemetery District for the mid-range estimated value indicated above.

**Section 3. Equipment, Maintenance & Rental Fund.** All proceeds from the sale of the Surplus Personal Property shall be deposited in the Equipment, Maintenance & Rental Fund, established pursuant to SMC 3.04.120.
