DESCRIPTION OF THE PROGRAM/PROJECT AND BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Equipment Maintenance and Rental Fund has identified a 1996 Ford F-150 with 98,762 miles as surplus to the needs of the city. The Shelton Cemetery District recently contacted the city seeking assistance with their current vehicle that is in need of repairs that will cost more than the District's current vehicle is worth. The District asked if the city had an asset that would meet their needs that is no longer needed by city staff to perform city business. The vehicle identified by the attached resolution was identified, and the asking price is within the range provided by Kelly Blue Book.
